## **GRADE 11 ASSESSMENT POLICY - 2020**

Based on R.V. 094 - 2020 "Standard for the Evaluation of Competencies of Students in Basic Education"

### **1. STUDENT INFORMATION AND DATA**

It is important that parents review and update their children's information that appears in the SGO 11th grade registration process, especially the writing of all names and surnames, for the preparation of documents and certificates. ### **2. CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTION, PEDAGOGICAL RECOVERY AND CONTINUATION**

#### **2.1. Scale of qualification:**

The grading scale is vigesimal, with a minimum grade of 11 being considered as a passing grade.

#### **2.2. The bimestral qualification of the competences:**

At the end of each bimester, students will have a qualification for each competence, associated with each course, which will give an account of their progress in the development of the same.

#### **2.3. The annual qualification of the course:**

The annual qualification of the course will be determined on the basis of the qualifications obtained in the competencies associated with the course at the end of the fourth bimester of the academic year.

#### **2.4. Termination, recovery and continuation requirements**

- **TERM OF REGULAR BASIC EDUCATION:**
  - When, at the end of the school year, they pass all the courses, including the one pending rectification.
  - When at the end of the Pedagogical Recovery Programme or the Reassessment, they pass all the courses.
- **PERMANENCE (Repetition)**
  - When, at the end of the school year, they fail four or more courses, including the course to be rectified.
  - When at the end of the Pedagogical Recuperation Program or the Recuperation Evaluation they fail two or more courses, including the course pending rectification of the previous grade.



- PEDAGOGICAL RECOVERY

- Students who failed one, two or three courses, including the course to be remedied, may participate in remedial teaching or assessment.
- When you fail a course at the end of the Remedial Teaching Programme, it will be assessed monthly.

### **3. OF THE OFFICIAL GRADUATION AND GRADUATION CEREMONY ORGANIZED BY THE SCHOOL**

3.1. To officially graduate, students must pass different grade 11 courses and the course in charge of the previous year, if any.

3.2. In order to participate in the Graduation Ceremony organized by the school, grade 11 students must fulfill the following conditions:

- Approve all courses.
- Submit their Monograph.
- Comply with the requirements of Theory of Knowledge
- Comply with CAS Program requirements
- Pass with a minimum grade of A, in Democratic Coexistence.
- Obtain the approval of the academic and administrative area in the form of a "Report of Conformity for Graduation" and the favourable approval of the Coordinator of the International Baccalaureate Programme (IB).

3.3. During the graduation ceremony, students who have excelled academically will be recognized as being able to graduate with:

- Merit, if the students are within the top 10 places of grade 11 - 2020.
- Distinction, if the students are within the top 10 places of the promotion during the 5 years of studies of the high school level.

3.4 The IB Programme Coordinator is responsible for informing parents if students have met the requirements to be able to participate in the graduation ceremony.

3.5. Meeting the conditions established in point 3.2 is a requirement, without exception, for the student to be able to participate in the Graduation Ceremony. Non-participation in the ceremony does not restrict the student's right to be an official graduate and to receive his/her certificate of studies.
